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## **Rules & Protocols**

- 1) No choke, prong or shock collars are allowed in the building. Please bring a regular leash, no flexi/retractable leashes.
- 2) Treats will not be provided so please bring lots of small high value training treats as you will go through a lot during class. We recommend boneless skinless chicken breast, string cheese, hotdogs, or freshpet.
- 3) Payment for the following month is before the 25<sup>th</sup> of each month in order to reserve your spot. The spots not paid for by the 25<sup>th</sup> will be opened to the waitlist.
- 4) All students must take at least one full month of puppy or manners class and have permission from their instructor before moving up into other classes.
- 5) Please pick up after your dog if the dog goes to the bathroom in the facility or on the shopping center property. Please be respectful to the other students and customers in the shopping center
- 6) Do not let your dog go up to other dogs. The only exception to this is during off leash playtime at the end of puppy classes.
